



#### 🕆 Today's Gospel » Matthew 11:28–30 📩

Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls" (11:29).

#### Today's Gospel » Luke 1:57-66 📩

It was the day to name Elizabeth's baby. The priest was going to name the baby Zechariah, who was Elizabeth's husband. Zechariah had been unable to speak for months. He asked for a writing tablet and wrote the name he wanted for the baby. Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue freed, and he began to speak, praising God (1:63–64).

When the angel Gabriel appeared to Zechariah and told him his wife would have a baby, Gabriel told Zechariah what name to give the baby. Zechariah couldn't believe that his wife, who was very old, could still have a baby. Gabriel then told him that because he doubted God's power, he would not be able to speak until after the baby was born.
